


#### St. Rose Food Collection

# MARTIN LUTHER KING DAY REMEMBERING A CHRISTIAN ACTIVIST

Martin Luther King, Jr. (January 15, 1929 – April 4, 1968) was an American clergyman, activist and prominent leader in the African-American civil rights movement. In 1964, King became the youngest person to receive the Nobel Peace Prize for his work to end racial segregation and racial discrimination through civil disobedience and other non-violent means. He was posthumously awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 1977 and Congressional Gold Medal in 2004; Martin Luther King, Jr. Day was established as a U.S. national holiday in 1986.

When speaking about how he wished to be remembered, Martin Luther King said: "I'd like somebody to mention that Martin Luther King, Jr., tried to live his life serving others. I'd like for

somebody to say that Martin Luther King, Jr., tried to love somebody. "I want you to be able to say that day that I did try to feed the hungry. I want you to be able to say that I did try in my life to clothe the naked. I want you to say on that day that I did try in my life to visit those who were in prison. And I want you to say that he tried to love and serve humanity."


