When speaking about how he wished to be remembered, Martin Luther King said: “I’d like somebody to mention that Martin Luther King, Jr., tried to live his life serving others. I’d like for somebody to say that Martin Luther King, Jr., tried to love somebody. “I want you to be able to say that day that I did try to feed the hungry. I want you to be able to say that I did try in my life to clothe the naked. I want you to say on that day that I did try in my life to visit those who were in prison. And I want you to say that he tried to love and serve humanity.”

Help Our Scout Troop Raise Some Dough!

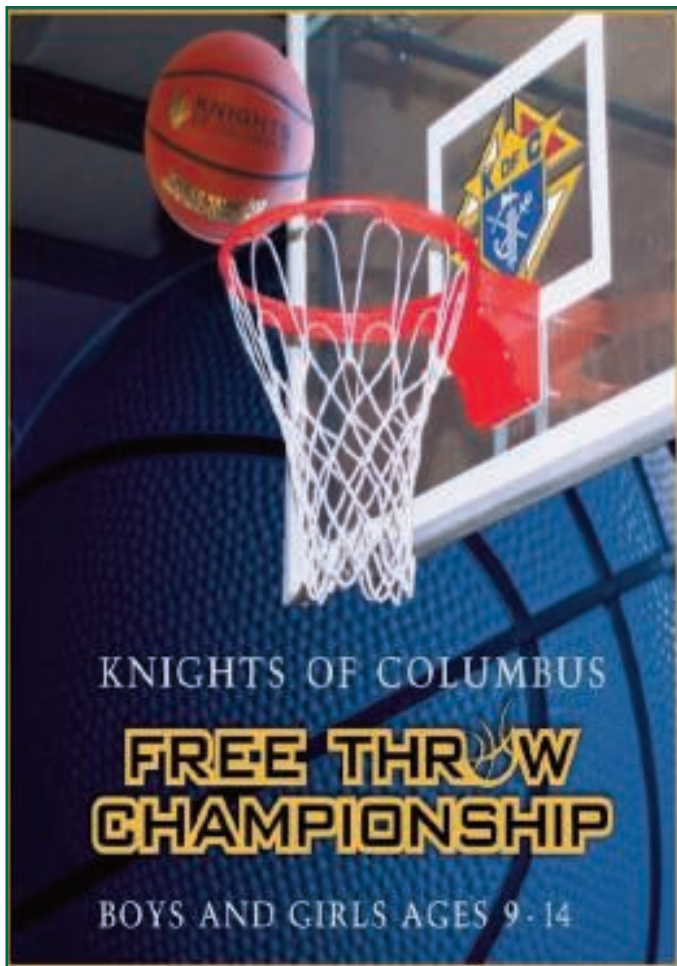

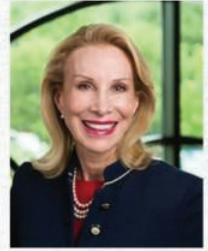
