



I'd like for somebody to say that Martin Luther King, Jr., tried to love somebody. "I want you to be able to say that day that I did try to feed the hungry. I want you to be able to say on that day that I did try in my life to visit those who were in prison. And I want you to say that he tried to love and serve humanity."






