

Saint Blaise Thursday, February 3 Mass 8:30 AM

February 3 is the Feast of St. Blaise, the one day on which the church extends the blessing of the throats. Since the ninth century, St. Blaise has been the patron saint for diseases of the throat. From the eighth century he has been invoked on behalf of the sick, especially those afflicted with illnesses of the throat. (Book of



Blessings, no. 1625) We know very little about St. Blaise

beyond the fact that he was a bishop in Armenia, who suffered martyrdom about the year 316. The blessing of the throats on his feast is attributed to his healing of a young boy who was choking to death on a fish bone stuck in his throat. This is why throats are blessed at Masses and other Liturgies on his feast day.

For the blessing, the priest, deacon or other minister touches the throat of each person with crossed candles (blessed on the feast of the Presentation of the Lord) and says:
“Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, Bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness; In the name of the Father, and the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.”




