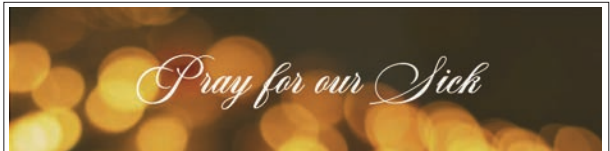

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT



This Sunday's liturgy focuses on faith and trust in God and gives us a kind of preview of Christ's resurrection in the Gospel reading of the transfiguration. On the mountain of transfiguration the disciples witnessed the glory of Jesus' identity as the "chosen Son." We, too, are destined for glory when Christ will "change our lowly body to conform with his glorified body" (Euch. Prayer). On that day our identity as God's sons and daughters will be fully revealed. It is interesting to note that the transfiguration story is revisited on August 6 with its own feast and a very different liturgy focusing on triumph, praise, and exaltation.

Reflection — Glory-Sharing and Cross-Carrying

We come to this Lenten liturgy today to be confronted with a glory story. We are indeed "confronted" but not immediately consoled because the glory of the transfiguration also pointed to the humiliation and suffering Jesus was to undergo. Yet we must also remember that the glory of the transfiguration was a sign of what was yet to be revealed in Christ's resurrection from the dead.

Today's liturgy reminds us of the transfigured glory of Jesus who, now in eternal glory in heaven, sustains us and helps us to face the humiliations, the sufferings, and the trials of this life that lead to life with him in his kingdom. But like the disciples of Jesus, we do not understand. The disciples fail to see that suffering, renunciation, and even deaths are required for one to share in the risen life of Christ. Is it any different in our lives? When suffering enters our lives what is our response? In Christianity it is not a question of experiencing suffering or glory, but of experiencing both. — Kevin Irwin

Why Confess to a Priest?

God so loved the world in the fullness of time God sent his Son. Why must one confess one's sins to a priest and not do so directly to God? Of course, one always addresses God when confessing one's sins. However, that it is also necessary to do so to a priest is something that God himself makes us understand: In sending his Son with our flesh, he shows he wants to encounter us through a direct contact that passes through the signs and language of our human condition.

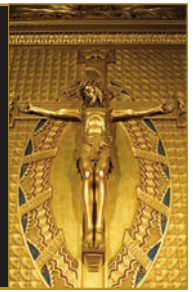

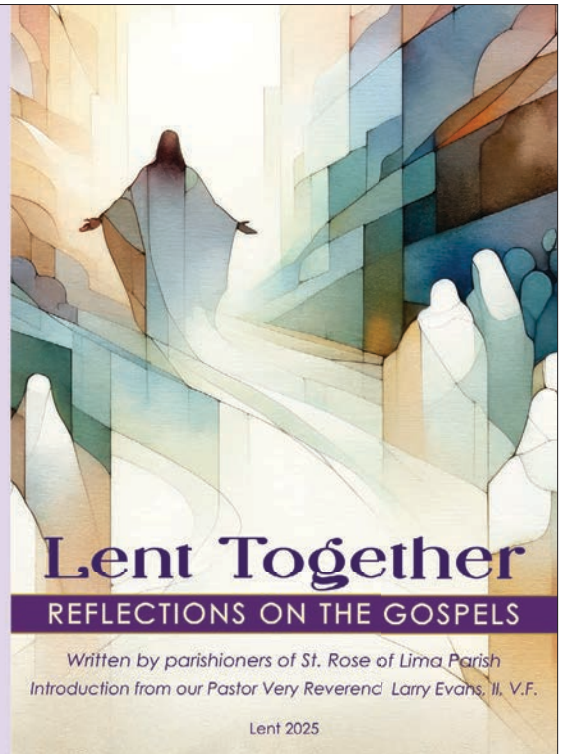
