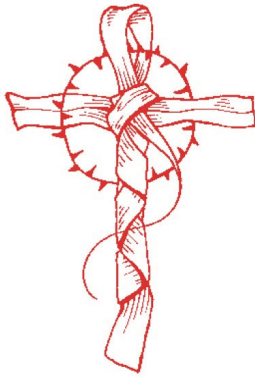

PALM SUNDAY OF THE LORD'S PASSION



The proclamation of the Passion is central to the liturgy on this final Sunday of Lent. Because this is an A year in the three-year cycle of Sunday readings, the Passion according to Matthew is read.

Lent ends on the afternoon of Holy Thursday. The season known as Triduum begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on that evening. Triduum is celebrated as a unit which is why the Mass of the Lord's Supper and the liturgy for Good Friday have no concluding rites. The final blessing does not occur until the end of Mass at the Easter Vigil.

"CRUCIFY HIM"

The message of the liturgy in proclaiming the passion narratives in full is to enable the assembly to see vividly the love of Christ for each person, despite their sins, a love that even death could not vanquish. The crimes during the Passion of Christ cannot be attributed indiscriminately to all Jews of that time, nor to Jews today. The Jewish people should not be referred to as though rejected or cursed, as if this view followed from Scriptures. The Church even keeps in mind that Jesus, his mother Mary, and the Apostles were all Jewish. As the Church has always held, Christ freely suffered his passion and death because of the sins of all, that all might be saved. (USCCB)

The proclamation of the passion at SRL will be proclaimed in full with shifts in voice by scene rather than by narrator/speaker.

REFLECTION—THE PASSION

The assembly that gathers to hear the proclamation of the Passion hears a familiar story. There will be no new characters in the cast, no sudden shift in plot line that cannot be anticipated, no surprise ending. We have heard the story before. This year when we hear the Passion it will be with the understanding that throughout the story we find bits and pieces of who we are today. There is something in all of us of the women and men of Christ's Passion.

We who are heirs to what Paul remembered, what the church remembered over all these years, are also the ones who must leave the story to the next generation. We must ensure that it is not forgotten or lost in a world that offers so many conflicting notions of meaning and memory. We believe that somehow in the mystery of retelling the story, it comes to life for us, draws us beyond the moment and sustains us in its image. Through this story, like no other, we can trace our own passage from life, through death, to life again!

One of the less emphasized rubrics contained in the liturgy of the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper is that gifts for the poor may be collected at the time of the presentation of the Eucharistic gifts. This custom is actually ancient and reflects the liturgical tradition of the Roman liturgy. The taking and collecting of gifts for the Eucharist always implies the sharing of some of those gifts with the poor.

There is a collection on Holy Thursday. An envelope is provided with your Sunday collection envelopes. All will be invited to come forward and place their offering in the baskets provided.

CELEBRATES 50 YEARS OF SERVICE



- \$350,000 raised for charities in past 15 years.
- \$30,000 Raised for the purchase of 3 ultrasonic machines for pregnancy care centers. Machines and their respective images of the fetus has resulted in 92% full term pregnancies.
- \$32,000 raised for 1,400 Coats for Kids.
- Support for the Parish both financially and with donated labor and materials.

The Order of the Knights of Columbus is the world's largest Catholic fraternal service organization. It was founded in the United States in 1882 by Fr. Michael J. McGivney at St. Mary's Parish in New Haven Connecticut to pool funds to care for the local families of mostly Catholic, immigrant coal miners who had died or become disabled in their occupation.

It is named in honor of Christopher Columbus and dedicated to the principles of Charity, Unity, Fraternity and Patriotism. The Knights' motto is "In Service to One, In Service to All".

Our local St. Rose of Lima Council 6386 is celebrating their 50th anniversary with some of our charter members still active. They have raised over \$350,000.00 for charities in the past 15 years. The Council raised more than \$30,000.00 for seed money the purchase of 3 ultrasound machines for pregnancy care centers. Their annual projects include "Coats for Kids" raising more than \$32,000.00 in the past 5 years to provide over 1,400 winter coats for local needy children. And, a gala event raised \$10,000 for Magnificat House in Jersey City which provides room and shelter to single people, mostly women, in repurposed convents.

In the 10 years before covid, the St Rose Council also raised over \$100,000 for Alzheimer's research, \$60,000 for scholarships for local students, \$125,000 for Intellectual Disability home support. This was carried out by St Rose parishioners providing modest amounts of volunteer time together to achieve these goals.

The K of C has always supported the Parish both financially and with donated labor and materials when needed around the Parish campus.

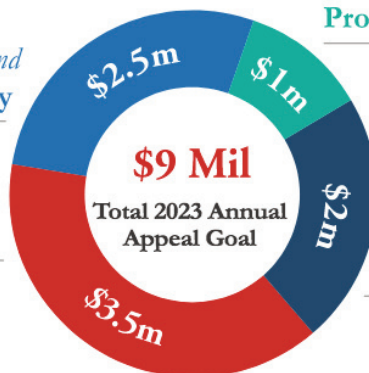

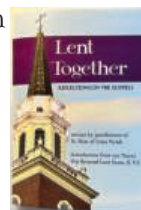

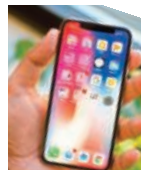
