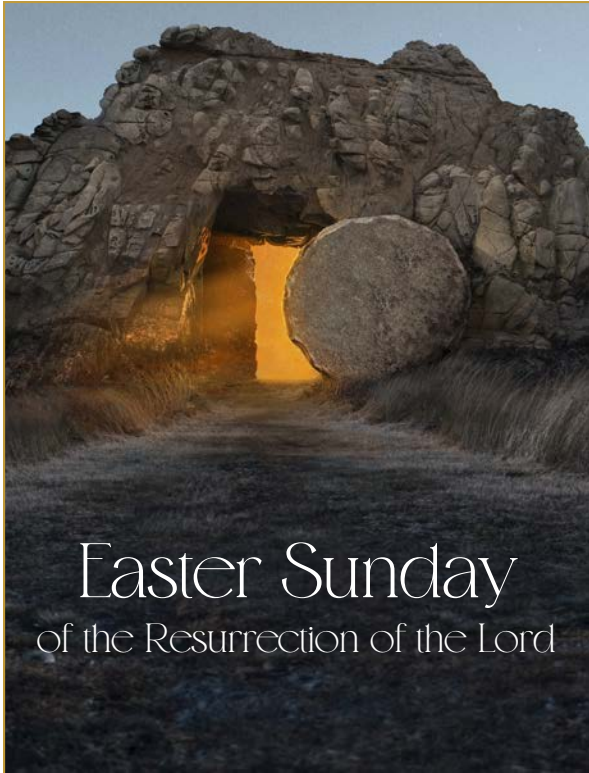

Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord

Reforming our lives during Lent has led us to renewing our Baptismal promises at this Easter celebration. Each Sunday during the Easter season, we should recall our baptism through the rite of blessing and sprinkling holy water.

This is the ideal time of year to celebrate not only baptism but also confirmation and first communion, the sacraments which complete the Christian initiation process begun with baptism.



The Easter Egg

The egg is like Jesus' tomb. It is enclosed, it is quiet and lifeless. Yet within an egg, the promise of new life is waiting to burst forth. Jesus's tomb was like an egg until early on Easter when Jesus rose up to a new and glorious life. Because of this rich symbolism, we add beautiful decorations to our eggs at Eastertime. Candy makers have added even more richness by creating wonderful candy treats in the shape of eggs.

Reflection—"Speak, Mary, declaring what you saw" (Easter Sequence)

Alleluia! This is the day that the Lord has made, but the celebration of Easter compels us to action. Today's texts are full of action verbs: We are witnesses . . . commissioned to preach . . . seek what is above . . . clear out the old yeast . . . celebrate the feast . . . she ran . . . they ran . . . he saw and believed. The power that impels such action is nothing less than the power of the Holy Spirit that raised Christ from the dead and made us "children of the light" (Easter Preface II). So take time to celebrate the feast, rejoice in the resurrection, revel in Christ's victory. But realize that our celebration also impels us to preach, to testify, to give witness to the faith that is within us, to join the struggle against all forms of bondage and death. We celebrate that Christ "reigns immortal" after "death and life have contended in that combat stupendous," but death still tries to defeat life, and people still try to bind others in chains. As children of the resurrection, it is our task to "clean out the old yeast" so that the whole of creation may feast "with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth."

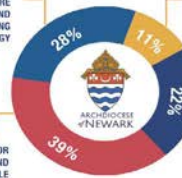
