

Reflection—"Speak, Mary, declaring what you saw" (Easter Sequence)

Alleluia! This is the day that the Lord has made, but the celebration of Easter compels us to action. Today's texts are full of action verbs: We are witnesses . . . commissioned to preach . . . seek what is above . . . clear out the old yeast . . . celebrate the feast . . . she ran . . . they ran . . . he saw and believed. The power that impels such action is nothing less than the power of the Holy Spirit that raised Christ from the dead and made us "children of the light" (Easter Preface II).

So take time to celebrate the feast, rejoice in the resurrection, revel in Christ's victory. But realize that our celebration also impels us to preach, to testify, to give witness to the faith that is within us, to join the struggle against all forms of bondage and death. We celebrate that Christ "reigns immortal" after "death and life have contended in that combat stupendous," but death still tries to defeat life, and people still try to bind others in chains. As children of the resurrection, it is our task to "clean out the old yeast" so that the whole of creation may feast "with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth." — Gordon Trui





EASTER — MORE THAN A SINGLE EVENT! EASTER — MORE THAN A DAY BUT A WAY OF LIFE




The Resurrection is not a single event, but a loosening of God's power and light into the earth and history that alter all things, infusing them with the grace and power of God's own holiness. It is as though a door was opened, and what poured out will never be stopped, and the door cannot be closed. Jesus Christ, "the first born from the dead," goes before us, and we follow after him, and in our baptisms we are continuing, exchanging, and transforming our life at birth into the life of being born in the waters of the tomb and the breath of the Spirit of God. This life frees

us from fear, from insecurity, from meaningless and from the power of sin, evil, injustice, and death itself. What holds onto us now, what saves us, what seeps through our bodies and souls is the grace and power of God, and our lives are no longer our own, but we are God's, as Jesus is God's beloved child. We are now the beloved children of God, calling God Our Father with Jesus, praying and living on that same Spirit that came upon Jesus in fullness and shared now with us, as his body in the world.

This mystery, the reality of what we seek to express, renders all existence altered, underlined now with hope, distilling love that is stronger than any other force on earth or in the heart. Death is shattered. Evil is empty. Injustice is null and void. Sin is shunted aside. Fear is useless. Insecurity is meaningless. Hate is pathetic. Suffering is turned inside out. Nothing is as it was, or will be ever again. There is a new order to creation; a new end to history; a new hope for the fullness of life for all; a new depth and even meaning to all that resists death and sin. All that is inhumane is undone. And when we have said all that, we have said little or nothing. The mystery is known in submission, in obedience, in shared struggle and enduring faithfulness that is first practiced with others on behalf of others or in the closing words of the Eucharistic Prayer: in him, and with him and through him-Jesus, in the Spirit of the glory of God the Father, until forever. AMEN.
