EASTER 5 - TABLE PRAYER

O God,
you graft us onto Christ, the true vine,

abundant fruits of faith and love.
Grant this through Jesus Christ, the resurrection and
the life, which lives and reigns with you in the unity
of the Holy Spirit, God forever and ever. Amen.

Reflection—I am the vine, you are the branches.

What better image could Jesus have used to show how closely united he is to us and we to him? The vine is the indispensable source of life and nourishment for the branches. No matter how healthy or beautiful a branch may appear, its very life depends on its remaining attached to the vine. Apart from the vine a branch can do nothing but wither and die. Yet if it stays attached to the vine, a branch can spread its beautiful foliage far and wide. One of the most beautiful things about each branch is its freedom. No one can tell a branch where to grow, where to curl, where to put forth fruit. It does all these things naturally and freely—but only if it remains united to the vine. The branch's freedom to become what it is meant to depends on its remaining attached to the vine. Jesus has told us, "I am the vine, you are the branches." Jesus is the indispensable source of our life. We produce the fruit of Christian life only if we remain united to him.

From: Catechism of the Catholic Church I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY CATHOLIC CHURCH

755 "The Church is a cultivated field, the tillage of God. On that land the ancient olive tree grows whose holy roots were the prophets and in which the reconciliation of Jews and Gentiles has been brought about and will be brought about again. That land, like a choice vineyard, has been planted by the heavenly cultivator. Yet **the true vine is Christ** who gives life and fruitfulness to the branches, that is, to us, who through the Church remain in Christ, without whom we can do nothing.

2074 Jesus says: "**I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in me, and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.**" The fruit referred to in this saying is the holiness of a life made fruitful by union with Christ. When we believe in Jesus Christ, partake of his mysteries, and keep his commandments, the Savior himself comes to love, in us, his Father and his brethren, our Father and our brethren. His person becomes, through the Spirit, the living and interior rule of our activity. "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you."

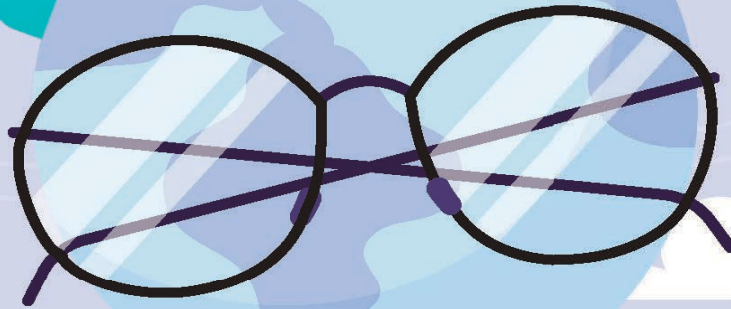

prescription & non-prescription, for children & adults are accepted**

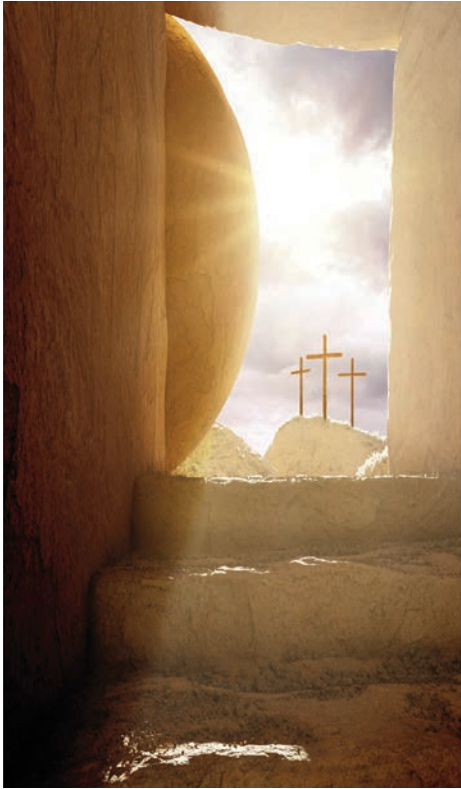
Reading glasses are useful for those who perform close up tasks while at work. Sunglasses are needed for people who live near the equator.

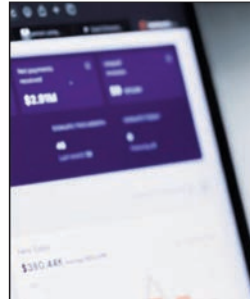

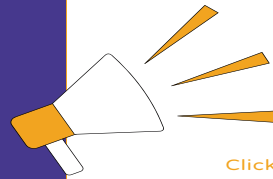

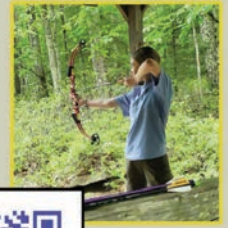
