Annual Appeal Progress:

April 27, 2023

The 2023 Annual Appeal is underway! We have **\$60,043.00** already pledged. This is approximately **53%** of our goal of **\$113,000.00**.

Your pledge and gift to this year's Appeal will also help St. Rose of Lima receive possibly two financial incentives. Donations in hand made by June 30, 2023, that exceed the Goal of **\$113,000.00** will make our parish eligible for a rebate. The actual rebate amount will be based on the funds collected by December 31, 2023.

Also, if we meet or exceed this goal in funds collected by **June 30, 2023**, St. Rose of Lima will receive a **2%** assessment rate reduction in our parish assessment for Fiscal Year 2024. This is a potential savings of **\$22,600.00** for our parish. St. Rose of Lima will use any rebate money or savings towards our parish needs such as our Church Steps Project.

I have made my pledge to this year's appeal. I invite you to join me and many of your fellow parishioners to consider making a pledge as well. You may fill out pledge cards in the church vestibule this weekend and mail it back to the Office of Development and Stewardship, place it in our collection basket or bring it to our parish office.

The cost per person is \$57.27 and includes the driver's tip.




