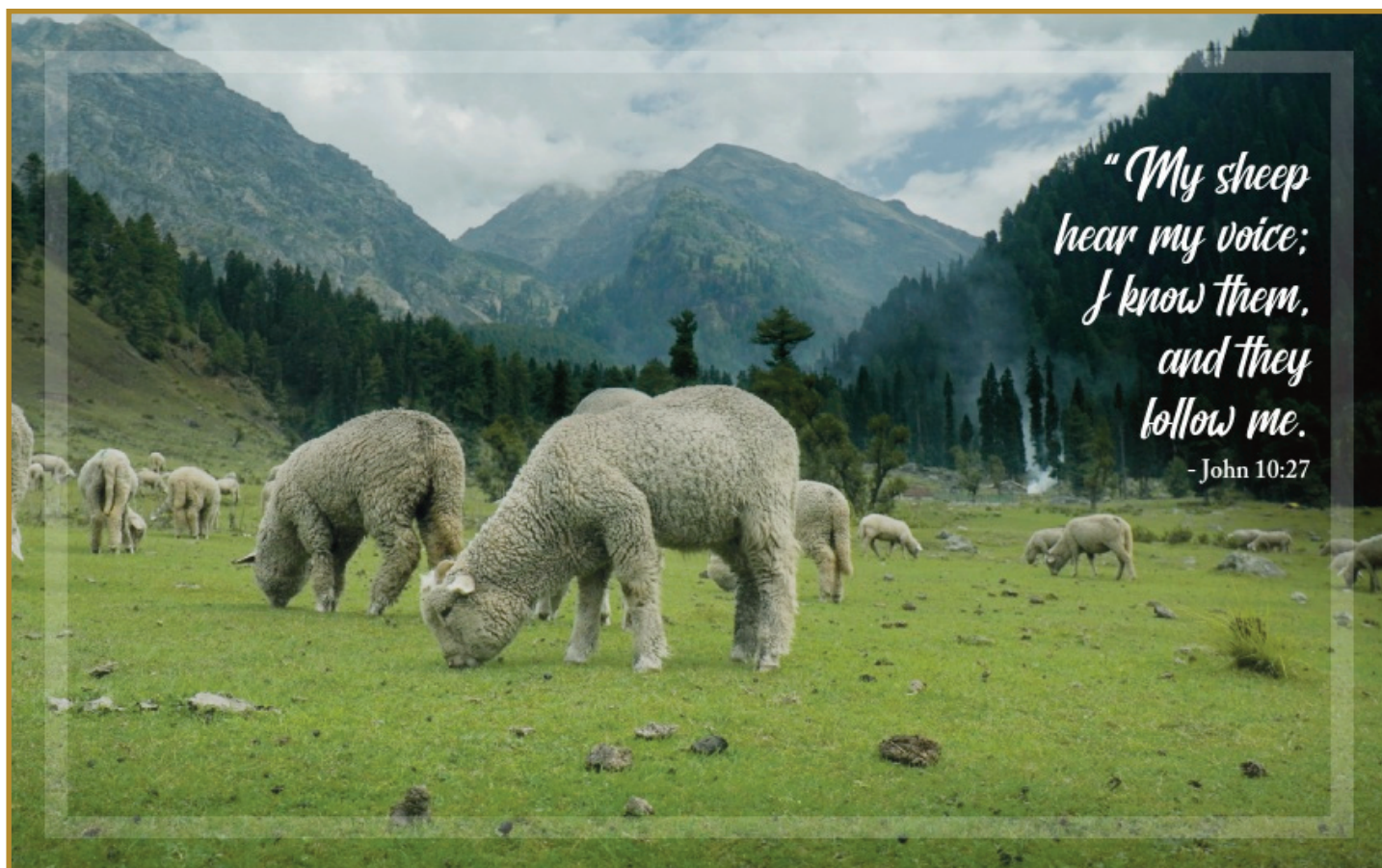

READING I

Acts 13:14, 43-52

Paul and Barnabas continued on from Perga and reached Antioch in Pisidia. On the sabbath they entered the synagogue and took their seats. Many Jews and worshipers who were converts to Judaism followed Paul and Barnabas, who spoke to them and urged them to remain faithful to the grace of God.

On the following sabbath almost the whole city gathered to hear the word of the Lord. When the Jews saw the crowds, they were filled with jealousy and with violent abuse contradicted what Paul said. Both Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly and said, "It was necessary that the word of God be spoken to you first, but since you reject it and condemn yourselves as unworthy of eternal life, we now turn to the Gentiles. For so the Lord has commanded us, I have made you a light to the Gentiles, that you may be an instrument of salvation to the ends of the earth."

The Gentiles were delighted when they heard this and glorified the word of the Lord. All who were destined for eternal life came to believe, and the word of the Lord continued to spread through the whole region. The Jews, however, incited the women of prominence who were worshipers and the leading men of the city, stirred up a persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and expelled them from their territory. So they shook the dust from their feet in protest against them, and went to Iconium. The disciples were filled with joy and the Holy Spirit.

FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

CHAPTER TEN OF THE GOSPEL OF JOHN PRESENTS THE IMAGE OF CHRIST AS GOOD SHEPHERD, the

charismatic and powerful leader willing to lay down his life for the salvation of the flock. Some part of this Scripture is read every year on the **FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER**. In chapter 10, which describes the role of the good or model shepherd, Jesus never talks about ruling. The role of the shepherd is to lead the sheep out to pasture, to know them personally so that they feel close to him, and especially to lay down his life for the sheep.

Let us pray for good shepherds in the Church.



GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY

*My sheep hear my voice;
I know them and they follow me.*
John 10

In the gospel for this Sunday, Jesus proclaims that his is the "good shepherd," that his flock hear his voice, and that he lays down his life for them. In the context of the second reading, however, we are more than Jesus' flock: we are "children of God" who are to "be like him." This means that we are not only sheep who hear our Good Shepherd's voice, but we also are to become shepherds ourselves. Transformed from sheep to shepherd, we take up the life he has laid down.

The image of the Good Shepherd (pictures on our walls or statues on our mantels) is not only a promise of divine care and protection; it is also a call to Christian mission.

FROM: CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

I believe in the Holy Catholic Church

751 The word "Church" (Latin *ecclesia*, from the Greek *ek-ka-lein*, to "call out of") means a convocation or an assembly. It designates the assemblies of the people, usually for a religious purpose. *Ekklesia* is used frequently in the Greek Old Testament for the assembly of the Chosen People before God, above all for their assembly on Mount Sinai where Israel

received the Law and was established by God as his holy people. By calling itself "Church," the first community of Christian believers recognized itself as heir to that assembly. In the Church, God is "calling together" his people from all the ends of the earth. The equivalent Greek term *Kyriake*, from which the English word Church and the German *Kirche* are derived, means "what belongs to the Lord."

754 "The Church is, accordingly, a sheepfold, the sole and necessary gateway to which is Christ. It is also the flock of which God himself foretold that he would be the shepherd, and whose sheep, even though governed by human shepherds, are unfailingly nourished and led by Christ himself, the Good Shepherd and Prince of Shepherds, who gave his life for his sheep.

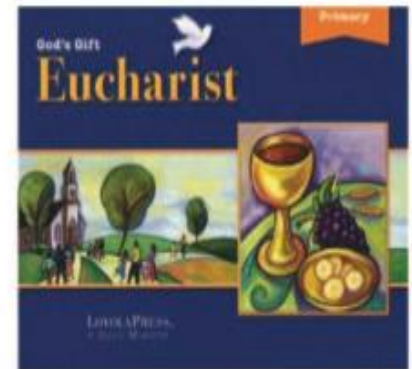



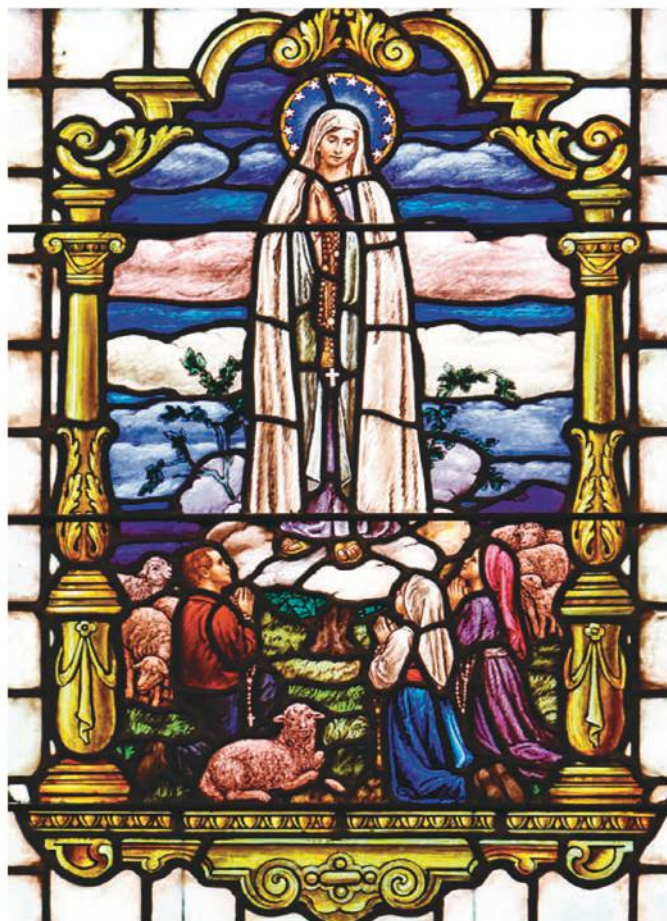

Our Lady of Fatima

Feast Day—May 13

Mary appeared to three peasant children near Fatima, Portugal, six times between May 13 and October 13, 1917, and asked for prayers for world peace and an end to World War I, for sinners, and for the conversion of Russia. She entrusted the children with three secrets, regarding devotion to her Immaculate Heart, a vision of hell, and a “bishop in white” shot by soldiers firing bullets and arrows. Many connect the third secret to the attempted assassination of Blessed Pope John Paul II on May 13, 1981, and the pope thanked Mary for guiding the bullet and saving him.

At the Vatican, Pope Francis has stood before the statue of Our Lady from the Fatima shrine and formally entrusted the world to Mary.

“In Lucia’s account, the three chosen children found themselves surrounded by God’s light as it radiated from Our Lady. She enveloped them in the mantle of Light that God had given her. According to the belief and experience of many pilgrims, if not of all, Fatima is more than anything this mantle of Light that protects us, here as in almost no other place on earth. We need but take refuge under the protection of the Virgin Mary and to ask her, as the Salve Regina teaches:

‘show unto us... Jesus.’” —Pope Francis, Holy Mass at the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima, May 13, 2017

What might we do in our daily lives to prepare us to more authentically hear the voice of the Good Shepherd?

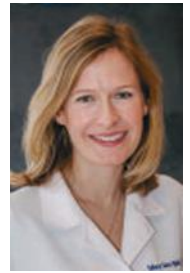

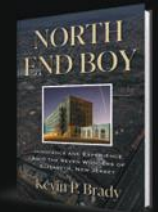
