#### **READING I**

After Paul and Barnabas had proclaimed the good news to that city

and made a considerable number of disciples, they returned to Lystra and to Iconium and to Antioch.

They strengthened the spirits of the disciples and exhorted them to persevere in the faith, saving,

"It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God."

They appointed elders for them in each church and, with prayer and fasting, commended them to the Lord in whom they had put their faith.




#### Fifth Sunday of Easter

ur first reading today and for all the Sundays of the Easter season is from the Acts of the Apostles.

#### Reflection—The Family You have Gathered Here Before You

Whatever we can say about the community that gathers for the Eucharist this Sunday, one if their description in the Eucharistic prayer is "family." That means whatever our political affiliation, our socio-economic status, our neighborhood, our nationality or lineage, we are called "family" at the Eucharist. The reason is that whatever our similarities or differences, we are gathered to worship the same God who has redeemed us by his Son and who has made us new, whole and one in Baptism. We belong to one another because we belong to Christ. We are members of "the Christian family."

One of the theological meanings associated with the Lord's Prayer and the sign of peace at the Eucharist is that we, though diverse, ratify our oneness in Christ through these words and this gesture. Just as words and gestures ratify family belonging, so these words and this gesture signify and confirm Christian family belonging in the Church.

One parallel between daily living in any family and daily life in the family of the church is the "family table." Just as families whatever their nature, eventually gather at table to share food and stories of life, so the church family gathers at the Eucharistic table to share food and stories of life. As we gather today as "the family [God] hasgathered here before him," may the food and stories strengthen us in the one thing that really matters in any family *-our love for one another*.







Our volunteers leave with full hearts knowing that because they are willing to give time and care, people leave Pierre Toussaint Pantry with food for their families and enough hope to sustain them a little longer. And **YOU**, you have shared in the continuing work of sharing sustenance for body and spirit for so many.

Inflation is hitting us all but of course those at the bottom of the economic ladder are hit the hardest. Yes, our statistics reflect that our numbers continue to climb again and we fear this to be true for the foreseeable future. We thank you for your support and the trust you place in us. 




