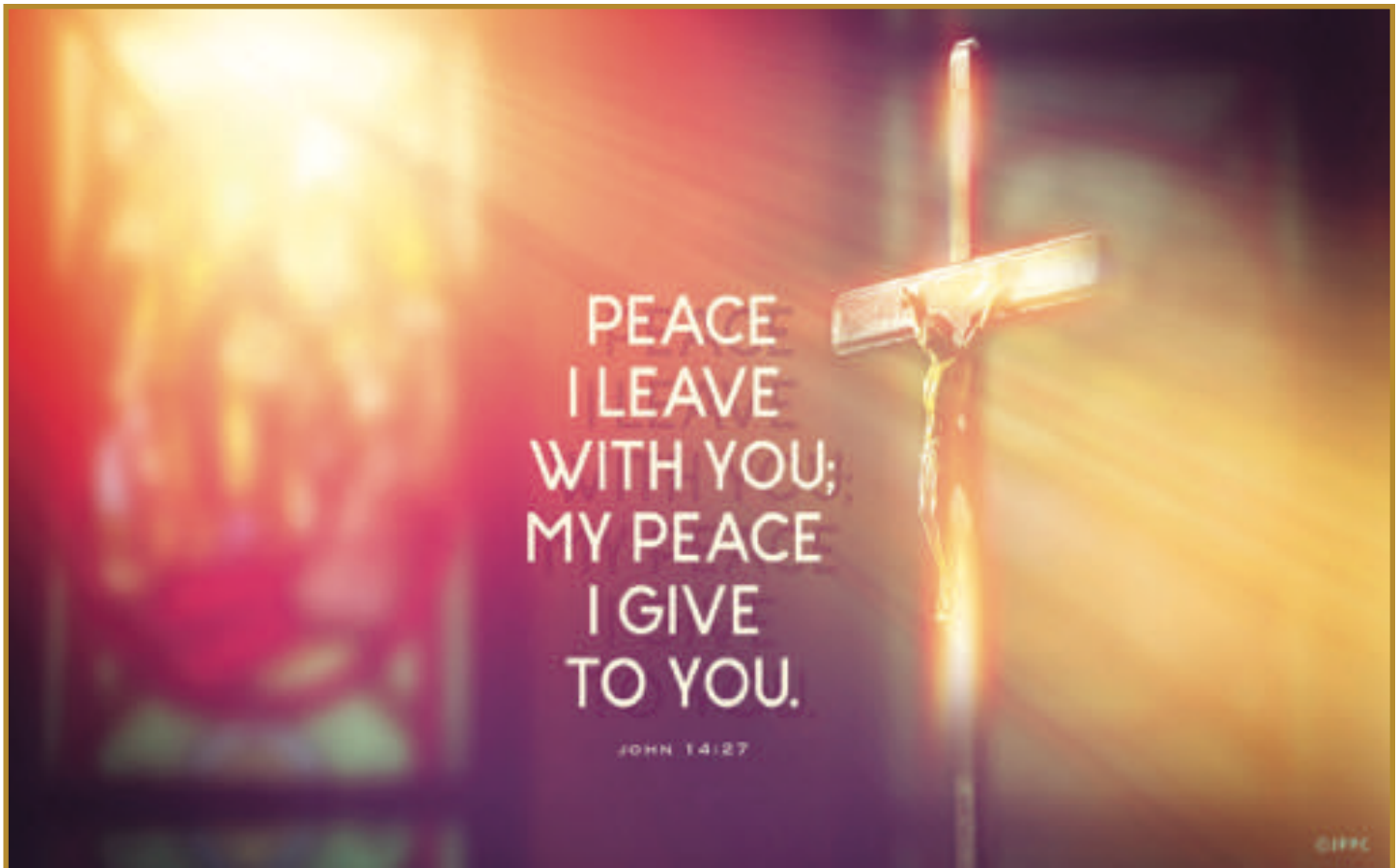

READING I

Acts 15:1-2, 22-29

Some who had come down from Judea were instructing the brothers, "Unless you are circumcised according to the Mosaic practice, you cannot be saved."

Because there arose no little dissension and debate by Paul and Barnabas with them, it was decided that Paul, Barnabas, and some of the others should go up to Jerusalem to the apostles and elders about this question.

The apostles and elders, in agreement with the whole church, decided to choose representatives and to send them to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas. The ones chosen were Judas, who was called Barsabbas, and Silas, leaders among the brothers. This is the letter delivered by them:

"The apostles and the elders, your brothers, to the brothers in Antioch, Syria, and Cilicia of Gentile origin: greetings. Since we have heard that some of our number who went out without any mandate from us have upset you with their teachings and disturbed your peace of mind, we have with one accord decided to choose representatives and to send them to you along with our beloved Barnabas and Paul, who have dedicated their lives to the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. So we are sending Judas and Silas who will also convey this same message by word of mouth: 'It is the decision of the Holy Spirit and of us not to place on you any burden beyond these necessities, namely, to abstain from meat sacrificed to idols, from blood, from meats of strangled animals, and from unlawful marriage. If you keep free of these, you will be doing what is right. Farewell.'"

Sixth Sunday of Easter

Easter is the church's first celebration to be noted in a special way beyond the weekly keeping of Sunday and, by the second century, seems to have been adopted by all Christian communities. This fifty-day celebration of resurrection, ascension and descent of the



Holy Spirit developed out of the Jewish Shavuot or Feast of Weeks, a fifty-day period following Passover. Because the first Christians were Jews, it should not surprise us at all that we maintain reflections of that heritage.

Reflection—Farewell Gifts

In this Sunday's gospel, Jesus describes what it means for disciples to love Jesus himself: they must keep his word. This is of paramount importance for the words Jesus speaks are really God's own words.

When disciples keep the word, both Jesus and God will dwell in them. To help disciples keep his words, Jesus will send the Holy Spirit to “teach you everything” and to “remind you of all that I told you”. The Holy Spirit will not only enable the disciples to recall what Jesus taught, but will also teach them how to live those words in every age. This is certainly the function of the Holy Spirit in the first reading as the Spirit guides the fledgling Church in matters unaddressed by Jesus in his earthly teachings.

Jesus not only gives the disciples his word and Spirit, he gives them his peace. Peace is not freedom from conflict, strife, or hostility. Indeed, Jesus is about to enter the greatest conflict of his life. Rather, it is the confidence that disciples will never be abandoned. Jesus will always be present to them through his word; the Father will dwell in them; the Holy Spirit will guide them. As Jesus is about to take his leave of the disciples, he gives them his word, the Holy Spirit, and his peace.

TRANSFER OF THE SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

St. Rose of Lima Parish Celebrates The Ascension of the Lord Sunday, May 29th

(Holyday of Obligation)

Issued March 23, 2022

The Latin-rite Diocesan Bishops of the Ecclesiastical Province of Newark have permanently transferred the observance of the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus from the Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter to the following Sunday. You will recall that such a transfer was made in 2020 and 2021 because of the pandemic.

Diocesan Bishops decided to transfer permanently the observance of the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus to the Seventh Sunday of Easter, effective this year. As a result, in 2022, the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus will be celebrated in all the Latin-rite dioceses of New Jersey on **Sunday, May 29, 2022.**

The bishops of New Jersey hope that the transfer will permit a greater number of Catholics to celebrate the Ascension of the Lord, which is an essential event in the great mystery of our Redemption.

Troop 17 Trip to Washington D.C.

Troop 17's Patrol Leaders Council and their families had a special trip to Washington, DC over Mother's Day Weekend.

The first morning, we took the DC Metro to L'Enfant Plaza and began a rainy 6+ mile hike called the James West Trail. Along the way, we answered clues and riddles to find specific locations. We saw amazing sites like the Capitol, Supreme Court building, US Botanic Gardens, National Archives, Library of Congress, the White House, the Washington Monument, the World War II Memorial and the Eisenhower Memorial. This hike earned us a special medal we can wear on our uniforms.

After lunch, we visited the National Museum of African American History & Culture. The museum's exhibits cover history from the slave trade through modern day and show the impact, hardships, and achievements of African Americans in the United States.

Around 7:30pm, we boarded a trolley for a nighttime tour of DC monuments. During the guided tour by "Mr. History" we got to explore some more famous sites in the dark, including the Lincoln Memorial, Vietnam Veterans Memorial, Korean War Veterans Memorial, the Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial, and the Franklin Delano Roosevelt Memorial. The mall was quieter and solemn, and cool to see at night.

The next morning, we visited the US Marine Corp War Memorial, the huge monument depicting Marines raising the flag at Iwo Jima. We then headed to Arlington National Cemetery and saw Marine One flying over DC.

At the cemetery, we visited the graves of John F. Kennedy and Robert F. Kennedy, and Arlington House, which we learned the night before was owned by Robert E. Lee before the Civil War.

Finally, Troop 17 was truly honored to take part in a wreath-laying ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. The Tomb Sentinels who guard the tomb explained what to do, and we carefully followed their instructions to honor those who lost their lives in war.

This trip was very memorable. We were lucky to have seen so much and privileged to represent Troop 17 as we paid our respects.

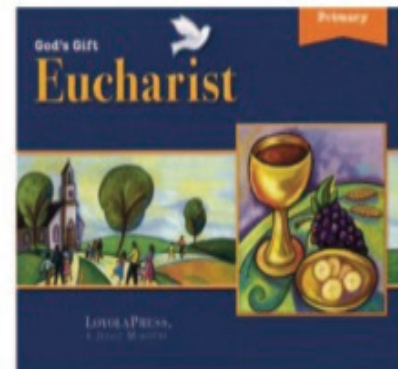



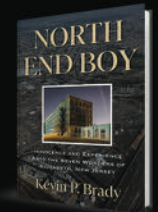
