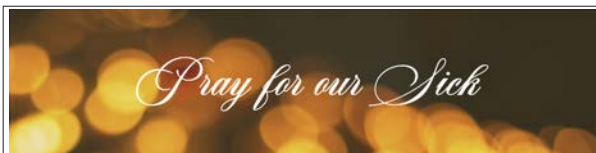

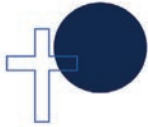

St. Ignatius of Loyola, (Basque: Iñigo Loiolakoa, Spanish: Ignacio de Loyola) (1491– July 31, 1556) was a Spanish knight from a Basque noble family, priest since 1537, theologian, who founded the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) and was its first Superior General. Ignatius emerged as a religious leader during the Counter-Reformation. Loyola's devotion to the Catholic Church was characterized by unquestioning obedience to the Catholic Church's authority and hierarchy.

Seriously wounded at the Battle of Pamplona (1521), he underwent a spiritual conversion while in recovery. *De Vita Christi* by Ludolph of Saxony inspired Loyola to abandon his previous military life and devote himself to labor for God, following the example of spiritual leaders such as Francis of Assisi. He experienced a vision of the Virgin Mary and the infant Jesus while at the shrine of Our Lady of Montserrat in March 1522. Between 1524 and 1537, Ignatius studied theology and Latin in Spain and then in Paris. In 1534, he arrived in the

latter city during a period of anti-Protestant turmoil which forced John Calvin to flee France. Ignatius and a few followers bound themselves by vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience. In 1539, they formed the Society of Jesus, approved in 1540 by Pope Paul III, as well as his Spiritual Exercises approved in 1548. Loyola also composed the Constitutions of the Society. He died in July 1556, was beatified by Pope Paul V in 1609, canonized by Pope Gregory XV in 1622, and declared patron of all spiritual retreats by Pope Pius XI in 1922. Ignatius' feast day is celebrated on July 31. Ignatius is a foremost patron saint of soldiers, the Society of Jesus, the Basque Country, and the provinces of Guipúzcoa and Biscay.

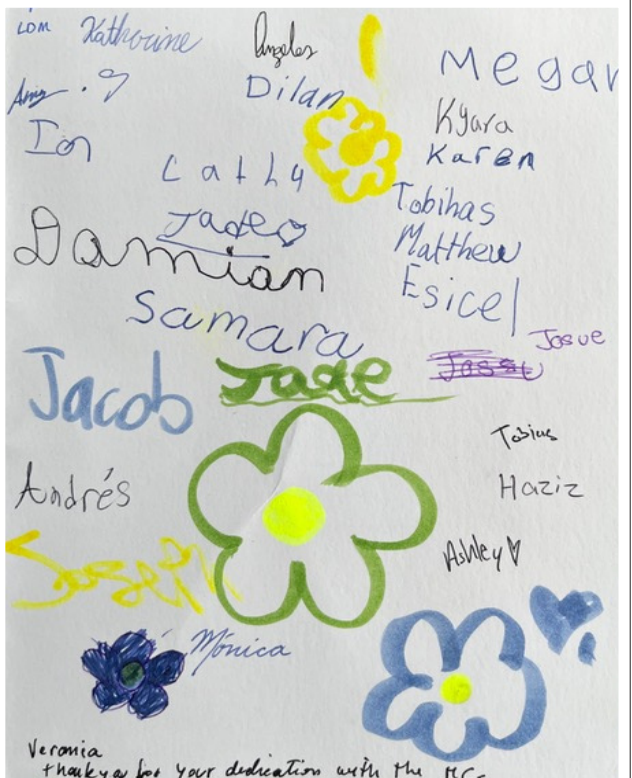
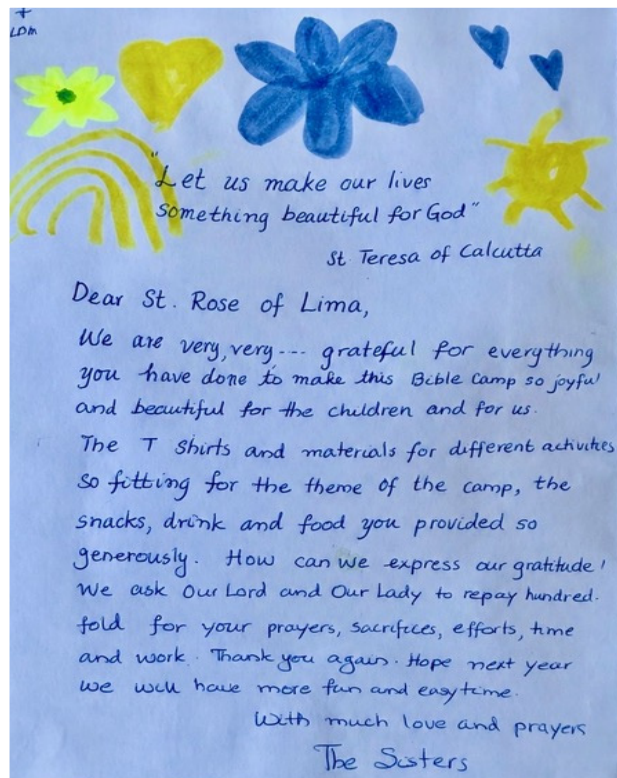
THANK YOU FROM MISSIONARIES OF CHARITY CAMP

Once again, the winds of Europe beckon to us to come and explore her treasures. This time we are called to sail on the Amadeus Provence and explore the Burgundy and Provence Region of France!

Enjoy this uniquely beautiful cruise along the French river of the Rhône and Saône. Experience picturesque villages, world-famous wine regions such as the Côte d'Or, unforgettable landscapes in the regions of Provence and Burgundy, and impressive views of historic cities and monuments.

The height of gastronomy is celebrated in Lyon, along with wine, art, architecture, scenery and history – all coming together in glorious harmony in the South of France.

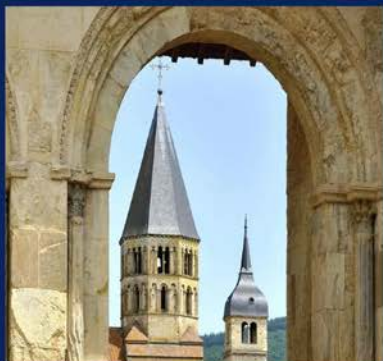
Our adventure will begin with our departure from Newark airport on Tuesday, 13 April 2027 and returning to Newark on Wednesday, 21 April 2027.

The price of the trip is \$5,100.00 per person based on double occupancy which includes the cost of the ship, excursions and transportation to and from the airport in Lyon. We recommend that each person book their own flight. Often people get pricing cheaper than what we can offer. Specific flight information will be available in July '26. You should set aside about \$1,500.00 (economy seating) for your flight, though as I said, by booking on your own, you may come up with something cheaper.

Attached you will find information regarding the excursions that we are offering. You can sign up for additional excursions once on the ship which are not included in this package.

We hope that you will consider joining us for what looks to be a magnificent time!
