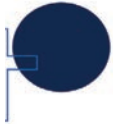

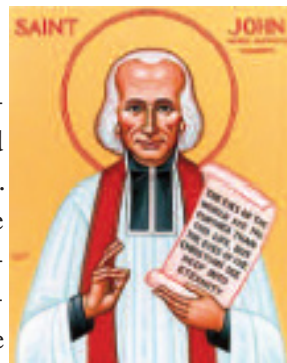


This Week in the Church Year

The Feast of St. John Vianney

August 4

The suppression of the Church during the French Revolution (1789-1799) resulted in an unchurched ignorant generation. Saint Jean Mary Vianney desired to draw these lost souls back to the Church and re-educate them in their faith. As the cure (parish priest) of the isolated village of Ars, he began by living a life of austerity and mortification, and brought catechesis and the sacraments, especially the sacrament of Reconciliation, back to the people. His reputation for holiness spread throughout France; so many wished to see the Cure de Ars, that one could wait over a week to see him.



The Feast of the Transfiguration

August 6



The Transfiguration Gospel is also heard on the Second Sunday of Lent each year. In that setting, the story prepares us for Easter and spurs us to moral conversion. Today's celebration has a different tone, however. It accentuates the awe and wonder of discovering who Jesus is: our God made visible. It encourages us to hope for the glory of heaven as well.

The Mountaintop Experience

At some moments we experience complete unity within us and around us. This may happen when we stand on a mountaintop and are captivated by the view. It may happen when we witness the birth of a child or the death of a friend. It may happen when we have an intimate conversation or a family meal. It may happen in church during a service or in a quiet room during prayer. But whenever and however it happens we say to ourselves: "This is it ... everything fits ... all I ever hoped for is here." This is the experience that Peter, James, and John had on the top of Mount Tabor when they saw the aspect of Jesus' face change and his clothing become sparkling white. They wanted that moment to last forever (see Luke 9:28-36). This is the experience of the fullness of time. These moments are given to us so that we can remember them when God seems far away and everything appears empty and useless. These experiences are true moments of grace.

The height of gastronomy is celebrated in Lyon, along with wine, art, architecture, scenery and history – all coming together in glorious harmony in the South of France.

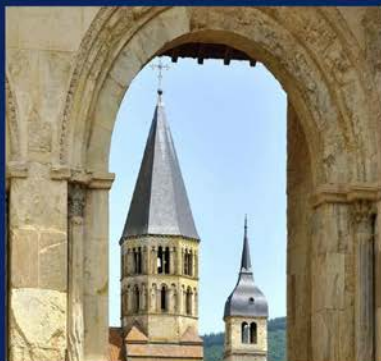
Our adventure will begin with our departure from Newark airport on Tuesday, 13 April 2027 and returning to Newark on Wednesday, 21 April 2027.

The price of the trip is \$5,100.00 per person based on double occupancy which includes the cost of the ship, excursions and transportation to and from the airport in Lyon. We recommend that each person book their own flight. Often people get pricing cheaper than what we can offer. Specific flight information will be available in July '26. You should set aside about \$1,500.00 (economy seating) for your flight, though as I said, by booking on your own, you may come up with something cheaper.

Attached you will find information regarding the excursions that we are offering. You can sign up for additional excursions once on the ship which are not included in this package.

We hope that you will consider joining us for what looks to be a magnificent time!
