Operation Paperback

Now collecting: Paperback books to send to US Military stations in the US and elsewhere. Please deposit new or gently used paperback books into collection boxes located in the church vestibule. You can also bring paperback books to our parish on Stewardship Day (Sept 6), a collection box will be available at the designated table.

Operation Paperback began in 1999, sending its first shipments to Kuwait and Saudi Arabia. We have since shipped 2.9 million books to over 30 locations overseas.




