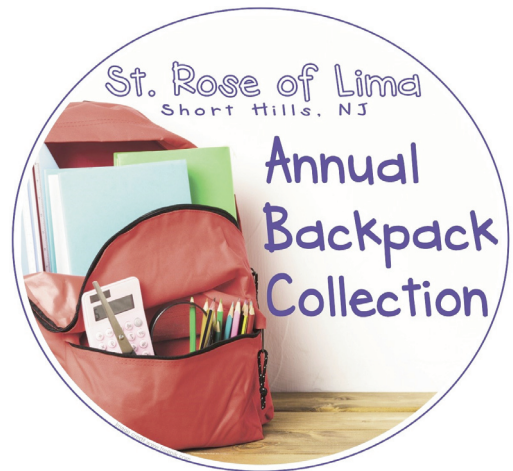
This year is even easier—no need to choose which school kits to purchase—instead just click on our backpack link and send us your desired monetary donation and we will do the rest!

This Week in the Church Year

THE FEAST OF THE TRANSFIGURATION

August 6



The Transfiguration Gospel is also heard on the Second Sunday of Lent each year. In that setting, the story prepares us for Easter and spurs us to moral conversion. Today's celebration has a different tone, however. It accentuates the awe and wonder of discovering who Jesus is: our God made visible. It encourages us to hope for the glory of heaven as well.

THE MOUNTAIN TOP EXPERIENCE

At some moments we experience complete unity within us and around us. This may happen when we stand on a mountaintop and are captivated by the view. It may happen when we witness the birth of a child or the death of a friend. It may happen when we have an intimate conversation or a family meal. It may happen in church during a service or in a quiet room during prayer. But whenever and however it happens we say to ourselves: "This is it ... everything fits ... all I ever hoped for is here." This is the experience that Peter, James, and John had on the top of Mount Tabor when they saw the aspect of Jesus' face change and his clothing become sparkling white. They wanted that moment to last forever (see Luke 9:28-36). This is the experience of the fullness of time. These moments are given to us so that we can remember them when God seems far away and everything appears empty and useless. These experiences are true moments of grace. *Henri Nouwen*

Jesus took Peter, James, and his brother, John, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. And he was transfigured before them; his face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light.

ST. DOMINIC

August 8



St. Dominic was the founder of the Friars Preachers, popularly called the Dominicans or Order of Preachers (OP). A man of remarkable energy, Dominic was once nicknamed "Athlete of the Lord." As he founded his Order of Preachers in the last decade of his short life (1170 - 1221), he traveled on foot all over Europe establishing communities in nine different countries. Following his example, his sons and daughters were among the first to travel to the Western Hemisphere when it was discovered two centuries after his death. On the island where they landed, Dominican missionaries are still remembered for their courageous stand in defense of the human rights of the indigenous peoples.

Since the time of St Dominic, more than 800 years ago, Dominicans have been living and sharing the message of the Gospel. Today thousands of sisters, nuns, priests, brothers, associates, and laity serve in more than 100 countries around the globe.

St. Rose of Lima was a Dominican religious. SRL Parish has a Dominican religious on staff, Sr. Donna Ciangio.

ST. LAWRENCE THE DEACON

August 10

St Lawrence was a deacon who lived in Rome at a time when Christians were being persecuted. He was closely associated with Pope Sixtus II, who was martyred a few days before Lawrence at the hands of Emperor Valerian. Popular tradition tells of Lawrence's gruesome death by fire, although he was most likely executed with a sword, which was the usual method of capital punishment at the time. He became one of the early church's most popular martyrs and was especially renowned for his alms giving. Together with St Steven, Lawrence is a patron of deacons.

The Order of the Knights of Columbus is the world's largest Catholic fraternal service organization. It was founded in the United States in 1882 by Fr. Michael J. McGivney at St. Mary's Parish in New Haven Connecticut to pool funds to care for the local families of mostly Catholic, immigrant coal miners who had died or become disabled in their occupation.

It is named in honor of Christopher Columbus and dedicated to the principles of Charity, Unity, Fraternity and Patriotism. The Knights' motto is "In Service to One, In Service to All".

Our local St. Rose of Lima Council 6386 is celebrating their 50th anniversary with some of our charter members still active. They have raised over \$350,000.00 for charities in the past 15 years. The Council raised more than \$30,000.00 for seed money the purchase of 3 ultrasound machines for pregnancy care centers. Their annual projects include "Coats for Kids" raising more than \$32,000.00 in the past 5 years to provide over 1,400 winter coats for local needy children. And, a gala event raised \$10,000 for Magnificat House in Jersey City which provides room and shelter to single people, mostly women, in repurposed convents.

In the 10 years before covid, the St Rose Council also raised over \$100,000 for Alzheimer's research, \$60,000 for scholarships for local students, \$125,000 for Intellectual Disability home support. This was carried out by St Rose parishioners providing modest amounts of volunteer time together to achieve these goals.

The K of C has always supported the Parish both financially and with donated labor and materials when needed around the Parish campus.

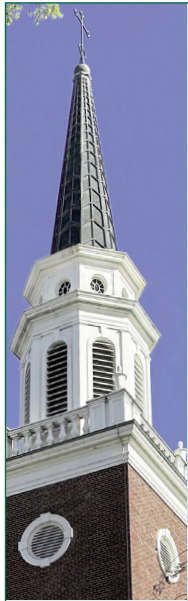
