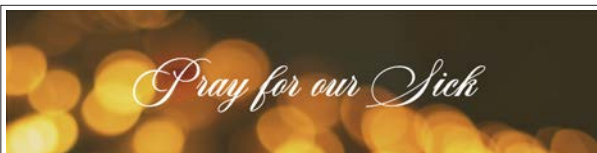

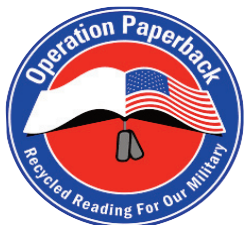

Operation Paperback

Now collecting: Paperback books to send to US Military stations in the US and elsewhere. Please deposit new or gently used paperback books into collection boxes located in the church vestibule. You can also bring paperback books to our parish on Stewardship Day (Sept 6), a collection box will be available at the designated table.

Operation Paperback began in 1999, sending its first shipments to Kuwait and Saudi Arabia. We have since shipped 2.9 million books to over 30 locations overseas.



Mercy House

Now collecting: New baby bottles, new sippy cups, blankets, bibs, baby diapers (all sizes), baby wipes, baby clothing (new/gently used sizes infant-4T).

The mission of Mercy House is to offer a welcoming space for families in need as well as to provide emotional support and healing. Their clients include migrants, low-income families and anyone in need. Their centers are able to supply basic household needs, food, clothing and supplies for babies and children.



Samaritan's Feet: Shoes for HOPE

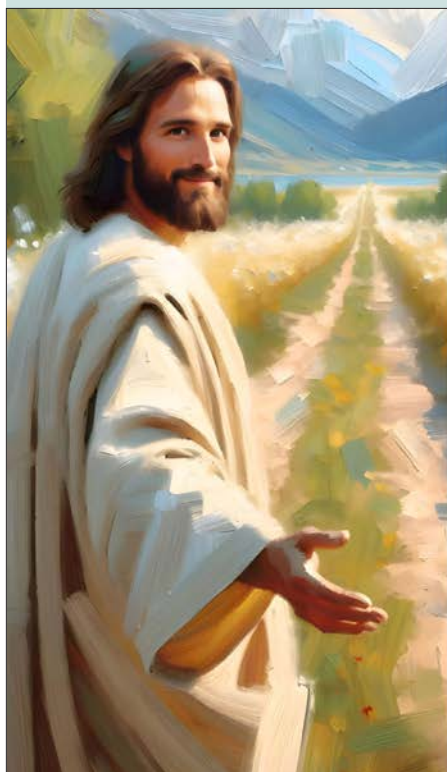

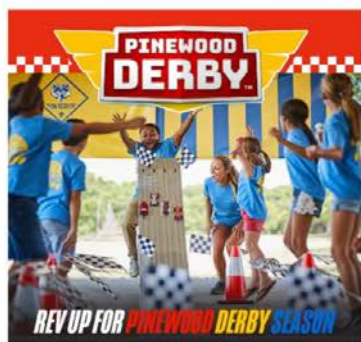

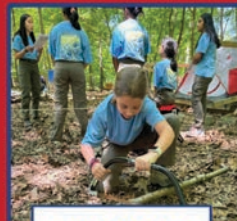
