




#### **AUGUST 22 - QUEENSHIP OF THE BVM**



This feast of the Queenship of the Virgin Mary was established by Pius XII in 1955 and was celebrated on 31 May. Since 1969 it has been observed on 22 August to stress its relationship to the Assumption (15 August): taken up into glory, Mary became queen of heaven and earth.

## Titular Feast of St. Rose of Lima

#### Parish Titular Feast of Saint Rose

The Church marks the titular (title) feast of a parish as a first class feast day. A plenary indulgence is granted to those who visit the parish church on its titular feast. In visiting the church one must pray an Our Father and the Creed. Celebrating a titular feast of a saint is honoring the the life of one who professed faith by their lives. The cult of the saints in the Church is not in the first place an attempt to support individual piety, but rather a manifestation of ecclesial spirit. Certain individuals by their death and life help to form the identity of a community by being models of Christ himself.

#### Feast of Saint Rose

Born at Lima (Peru) in 1586, Saint Rose died there on 24 August 1617. Having chosen not to marry, she joined the Dominican Third Order and modeled herself on Saint Catherine of Siena (29 April). A recluse and mystic, Rose is remembered for her radiant love of God and for the severe penance and hardships she endured during serious illness. She was the first saint of the Americas to be canonized (1671).

Pray for us, St. Rose, That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.


Ornament of Christian virgins,





The Gospel reading today starts with a question: "Lord, will only a few people be saved?" Jesus offers only a simple reply: Strive to enter through the narrow gate. Many will try to enter and will not be able. Good stewards know there is only one, narrow gate. Not everything will fit.

This narrow gate has no room for our accomplishments. No room for our money. No room for our possessions.

No room for anything else but those who've been good stewards of the Gospel. We can't custom build our own gates either. There is only one, narrow gate that happens to be open for a time, but for how long? What is our plan of action to get through that gate?




