

Pope Benedict XI Prayer at Ground Zero New York 2008

O God of love, compassion, and healing, look on us, people of many different faiths and traditions, who gather today at this site, the scene of incredible violence and pain. We ask you in your goodness to give eternal light and peace to all who died here -- the heroic first-responders: our fire fighters, police officers, emergency service workers, and Port Authority personnel, along with all the innocent men and women who were victims of this tragedy simply because their work or service brought them here on September 11, 2001.

We ask you, in your compassion to bring healing to those who, because of their presence here that day, suffer from injuries and illness. Heal, too, the pain of still-grieving families and all who lost loved ones in this tragedy. Give them strength to continue their lives with courage and hope.

We are mindful as well of those who suffered death

injury, and loss on the same day at the Pentagon and in Shanksville, Pennsylvania. Our hearts are one with theirs as our prayer embraces their pain and suffering.

God of peace, bring your peace to our violent world: peace in the hearts of all men and women and peace among the nations of the earth. Turn to your way of love those whose hearts and minds are consumed with hatred.

God of understanding, overwhelmed by the magnitude of this tragedy, we seek your light and guidance as we confront such terrible events. Grant that those whose lives were spared may live so that the lives lost here may not have been lost in vain.

Comfort and console us, strengthen us in hope, and give us the wisdom and courage to work tirelessly for a world where true peace and love reign among nations and in the hearts of all.

Anointing of the Sick within Mass

Please bring your sick and elderly family members to receive the comfort of the Sacrament of the Sick and to share in this special time of God's grace and love.

MINISTRY TO THE SICK AND ELDERLY OF ST. ROSE OF LIMA PARISH

Ministry to the Sick is a pastoral ministry of caring for those people hospitalized, in nursing homes, or confined to private homes.

Viaticum: Holy Communion for the Dying is often translated as food for the journey. The Viaticum along with the sacrament of Penance, prepares a person for the final journey through death to everlasting life.

The Communal Celebration of the Sacrament of the Sick is celebrated within Mass twice a year at St. Rose. The sacrament may be repeated if the recipient suffers from a different illness or injury, or if the same illness or condition becomes more serious. Elderly people may be anointed if they have become weakened even though no serious illness is present. Transportation to the celebration is provided if necessary.

Justin Ministry is ministry to the sick and homebound on Sunday. Every Sunday a team of ministers brings Eucharist to those who are unable to come to Church. They go to individual homes and to area nursing homes.

Mother Mary's apparitions as Velankanni Matha



Velankanni Matha, or "Our Lady of Good Health," is a Catholic title for the Blessed Virgin Mary. In India, she is venerated for apparitions and miracles attributed to her, which led to her shrine being called the "Lourdes of the East." She is revered by millions of people across faiths.

Miracle #1

In the 16th century, a Hindu boy was delivering milk when Our Lady appeared with her infant son. She requested milk for her child. After he generously gave some, the boy went to his customer's place where he found the pot was miraculously overflowing, a testament to her divine grace.



Miracle #2

Years later, Our Lady appeared to a lame boy, who was selling buttermilk sitting under a banyan tree. She asked for some, and upon giving it, Mother Mary healed him. She instructed him to tell others to build a chapel in her honor.



Miracle #3

A Portuguese ship, caught in a violent storm, sought refuge by praying to Our Lady. The storm subsided, and they safely landed near Vailankanni. In gratitude to our Mother, they built the first permanent chapel, which eventually became the basilica.
