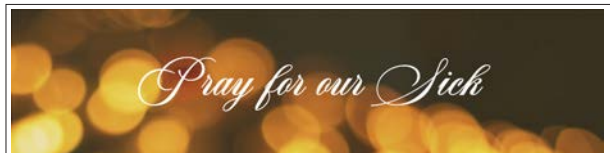

WHAT IS CATECHETICAL SUNDAY? The day which those designated to serve as catechists will be called forth to be commissioned for their ministry. Catechetical Sunday is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the role that each person plays, by virtue of Baptism, in handing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel. Catechetical Sunday is an opportunity for all to rededicate themselves to this mission as a community of faith.

HOW ARE PARENTS, THE PRIMARY CATECHISTS OF THEIR CHILDREN, RECOGNIZED ON CATECHETICAL SUNDAY?

Parents are truly the primary catechists of their children. They prepare the soil and plant the first seeds of faith. On Catechetical Sunday, we not only highlight the work of catechists in parishes and schools, but we also commend parents and guardians and encourage them to take seriously their role of making their Catholic households a place where faith is passed on to the next generation.

WHAT IS THIS YEARS THEME? The 2025 theme encourages us to be prepared to share the basis of our faith, the Lord, and the hope he provides. In the same manner Saint Peter encouraged the believers of his time, the Scripture reminds us, the sharing should be done with gentleness and respect.

HOW DO WE ANSWER THE CALL TO MISSIONARY DISCIPLESHIP AT ST. ROSE? The Parish of St. Rose of Lima is committed to supporting the Bishops call to missionary discipleship. In this Jubilee year, St. Rose is answering Christ's call to help our brothers and sisters who struggle with basic needs; food insecurity, clothing and school backpacks filled with needed supplies for children. Collections are held throughout the year: *Foodies for Families, Thanksgiving Food Basket Drive, Easter Food Basket Drive, Monthly Food Collection Sundays*. Each of these collections offer local food pantries a lifeline to help them keep up with enormous demand.

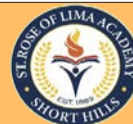

Welcome back Raven Nation and a special WELCOME to our new families. We love our sports at SRLA, and it's Cross Country season! If your child/children are interested in running with us this fall, please read this entire email as it contains a great deal of information about practices & meets.

Cross Country Team (XC)

The XC season runs from September until early November. The workouts consist of stretching, strength exercises, wind sprints, and kids running their meet distance twice to build stamina. We practice at Meisel Ave Park, Springfield, NJ

XC is open to grades K through 8.

K, 1st and 2nd grade athletes participate in a non-competitive half-mile fun run at the beginning of each meet. 3rd grade and up participate in timed, competitive divisions as follows (subject to change by hosts):

- JV Division – 3rd and 4th grades – $\frac{3}{4}$ mile
- JV Division – 5th and 6th grades – 1.25 miles
- Varsity - 7th and 8th grades – 1.8 miles

PLEASE NOTE: Parents or caregivers of children in K-2nd grade who are participating must remain at practice and keep an eye on their children at all times.

- Tuesdays: 5:45 pm to 7:00 p.m. Meisel Avenue Park, Springfield, NJ (Grades 3 to 8)

The practice schedule will be loaded into Doodlio. First practice is scheduled for Tuesday, September 16.

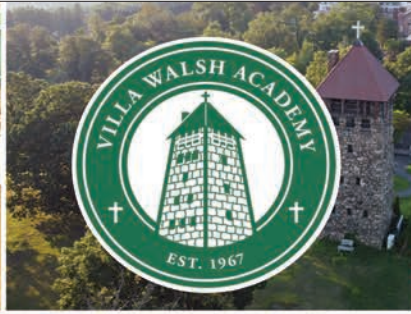
