



not
HOLLOW-een!

Halloween is the night of October 31. The word means "Hallow's Eve." "Hallows" is not a word that is foreign to us. Every time the Lord's Prayer is said reference is made to the name of God being "hallowed" or holy. Halloween means holy evening. In other words, Halloween is the evening before the feast of "All Hallows" or "all the holy ones," the saints—All Saint Day! So Halloween isn't just the way October ends. It also is the way November begins! On Halloween night—the eve of All Saint's Day— we begin the Church's month to remember the dead.

Halloween is not a separate celebration; rather, it is the beginning of the celebration of All Saints, a celebration that continues into All Souls Day, the day of the dead. Actually for a thousand years Halloween has been the eve or vigil of two feasts: All Saints and All Souls. Soon the whole month of November was devoted to remembering the faithful departed, the deceased.

To celebrate Halloween devoid of All Saints and All Souls is to empty the day of its meaning. It is no wonder Halloween is "hollow" for some Christians. Many see Halloween as filled with superstition and fear and therefore reject the festival or at best celebrate "Hollow" een. All Saints Day is one of the premier days of the Church's autumn calendar. Halloween is not a separate celebration, the holy eve of the great autumn festival to honor our holy ancestors in faith.
