Today is the first Sunday of Advent, the first day of the new liturgical year.

Advent, which always begins on the Sunday closest to November 30, dates back to the fourth century. It is a four-week period of devout and joyful preparation for the celebration of Christmas and for Christ's second coming at the end of time.

Early in Advent, the liturgy focuses our attention on the second coming. After December 16th, the liturgy shifts our attention to the events surrounding the nativity.

If you have been away from penance for some time, Advent is the perfect time, and the perfect way to come and celebrate God's mercy. There are "Going to Confession" cards at the doors of the Church that will help you with the "how to go" questions you might have.

Prayer as We Prepare our Homes for the Christmas Feasts





THINKING ABOUT YOUR RMD?

You can make a difference with your Required Minimum Distribution this year. Did you know that you can make a tax-free gift to St. Rose of Lima Church directly from your IRA through a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) in any amount up to \$108,000 in 2025?

When you make a QCD, your gift must go directly from your IRA Trustee to St. Rose and it will not be included as taxable income on your 2025 income tax return.

You must be age 70-1/2 or older at December 31, 2025 to qualify for this double benefit – St. Rose receives your gift and you do not pay tax on the gifted portion of your RMD.

You should make arrangements with your IRA Trustee as soon as possible if you plan on making a QCD this year as the logistics of the transfer to St. Rose may require some additional data gathering and Trustees are usually very busy at year end working on RMDs.

This suggestion does not constitute, and should not be considered as, tax advice and you should discuss this matter with your tax advisor before entering into any transaction with respect to your RMD.

Blessing of an Advent Wreath

The blessing of an Advent Wreath takes place on the First Sunday of Advent or on the evening before the First Sunday of Advent. When the blessing of the Advent Wreath is celebrated in the home, it is appropriate that it be blessed by a parent or another member of the family.

All make the sign of the cross.

Leader: Our help is in the name of the Lord.

Response: Who made heaven and earth.

Read one of the following Scriptures:

Isaiah 9: (lines 1-2 and 5-6)

Isaiah 63 (lines 16-17 & 19)

Isaiah 64 (lines 2-7) is read:

Leader: The Word of the Lord.

Response: Thanks be to God.

All join hands.

Leader: Lord our God, we praise you for your Son, Jesus Christ: he is Emmanuel, the hope of the peoples, he is the wisdom that teaches and guides us, he is the Savior of every nation.

Lord God, let your blessing come upon us as we light the candles of this wreath.

May the wreath and its light be a sign of Christ's promise to bring us salvation.

May he come quickly and not delay. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

Response: Amen.

The blessing may conclude with a verse from "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel":

O come, desire of nations, bind in one the hearts of humankind; bid ev'ry sad division cease and be thyself our Prince of peace.

Rejoice! Rejoice! Emmanuel shall come to thee, O Israel.
