## 3rd Sunday of Advent



## Gaudeamus

The traditional name for the Third Sunday of Advent is Gaudete Sunday. The name comes from Gaudete in Domino semper, Latin for “Rejoice in the Lord always,” opening words of today’s entrance antiphon.

We use the liturgical color of rose today as we rejoice that Christmas is near, and Christ’s second coming is nearer than it was yesterday.

### Advent 3 -Table Prayer

*Light three candles of the Advent Wreath.*

O God,  
to those who have hunger give bread;  
and to us who have bread give the hunger for justice.  
Blessed are you, O God in this food  
and in our sharing.  
Blessed are you as we wait in joyful hope  
for the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ.  
We ask this through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

### Reflection — Rejoice Always

In his love Christ has filled us with joy as we prepare to celebrate his birth, so that when he comes he may find us watching in prayer, our hearts filled with wonder and praise. Do we get so busy at this time of year with all “we have to do” that there is no time for silence, prayer and reflection on the astounding mystery of God made man, or Word made flesh? Are we so comfortable with the level of noise pollution in our lives that we almost forget what a silent night can be like?

Her “yes” to God made Christ’s first coming as we know it possible while her unquestioning faith and trust furnish us with a model to follow as we prepare for his second coming at the end of time.

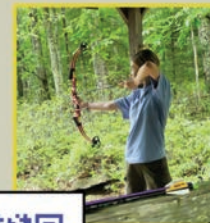
