

#### PROFESSION OF FAITH



# Fourth Sunday of Advent



The Advent liturgy emphasizes Mary and Joseph this Sunday, the two people immediately involved in the birth of Jesus. Today the lectionary assigns three important infancy narratives texts - Joseph's dream (Cycle A), the annunciation to Mary (B), and Mary's Visitation to Elizabeth (Cycle C). Mary and Joseph are presented as the model believers who did the will of God despite taxing, not to say confounding, circumstances. We are called to trust that the Lord's words, his promises, will be fulfilled.







#### The Saints Who Live Short Lives

As we see so many people die at a young age, through wars, starvation, AIDS, street violence, and physical and emotional neglect, we often wonder what the value of their short lives is. It seems that their journeys have been cut off before they could reach any of their goals, realize any of their dreams, or accomplish any of their tasks. But, short as their lives may have been, they belong to that immense communion of saints, from all times and all places, who stand around the throne of the Lamb dressed in white robes proclaiming the victory of the crucified Christ (see Revelation 7:9).

The story of the innocent children murdered by King Herod in his attempt to destroy Jesus (see Matthew 2:13-18), reminds us that saintliness is not just for those who lived long and hardworking lives. These children, and many who died young, are as much witnesses to Jesus as those who accomplished heroic deeds.



#### Stewardship Reflection for the Fourth Sunday of Advent December 18, 2022

In today's Gospel we hear of the coming of Emmanuel, which means "God is with us." We celebrate three Advents: the birth of Christ, his Second Coming, and his presence in the world today. Our daily lives are attended by God's presence. Indeed, "God is with us." The Good News of Christ's Incarnation is that we are the sign, the "sacrament," of Christ's presence in the world. People are supposed to see us, see how we love one another, see how we treat the stranger among us, see how we give comfort to the poor and afflicted, and share the Good News with joy. They see how good stewards are the light of Christ. And there can be no possible response except to say: "God is here!"




