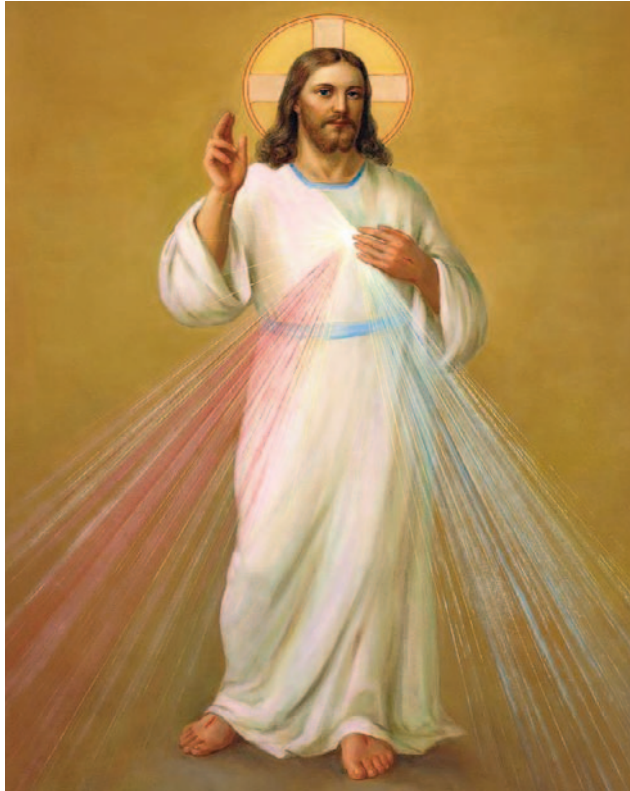

Reading 1


Acts 2:42-47

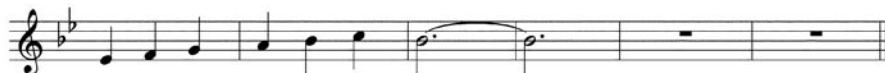

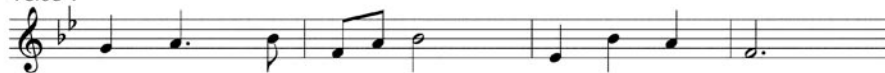
